



BEQUESTS AND DONATIONS

Courses and stays at Silver Wattle have been priced to cover our running costs. However our young Centre needs your support if we are to fulfil our vision. You can help by contributing through occasional donations, regular planned giving and by bequests. **These will ensure the long term viability of our work.**

We would very much appreciate donations or bequests - either while you are living so you can see the value in your own lifetime, or in wills. Bequests can be in money, property or other assets left to Silver Wattle. We can provide wording for consideration by your solicitor.

We have established three funds where you may direct your gifts.

Silver Wattle Appeal Fund (SWAF)

Money in this fund gives us the most flexibility for its use. Funds can be used for supporting attendance by those who are financially insecure, for periodic refurbishments and upgrading of equipment and for new initiatives. Contributions to the Appeal Fund are not tax deductible.

Silver Wattle Quaker Education Building Fund (SWQEBF)

Tax deductible receipts can be issued for contributions to the Silver Wattle Quaker Education Building Fund (SWQEBF). This Fund is to finance the acquisition, construction and maintenance of buildings and fixed assets that are part of the educational functions at Silver Wattle.

Silver Wattle Endowment Fund (SWEF)

The Endowment Fund is an investment fund from which the interest and investment income is available annually to underpin the Centre and its programs. Bequests to the Endowment Fund will benefit Silver Wattle in perpetuity.
